SECONDARY CURRICULUM – Jeffrey L. Deardorff, Chairperson

<u>APPROVAL OF OPERATION RECOGNITION</u>

Motion: Mr. Deardorff Second: Mr. Tuttle

WHEREAS, Section 1611 of the Pennsylvania Public School Code, as amended, authorizes Boards of School Directors to establish a program known as "Operation Recognition" which provides for the granting of high school diplomas to eligible honorably discharged veterans in a manner prescribed by the Board of School Directors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of School Directors ("Board") of Crawford Central School District ("District") desires to establish an Operation Recognition program in the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board, through this Resolution, is prescribing the manner in which the District's Operation Recognition program shall be established by the Administration.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

- 1. An Operation Recognition program is established in the District through which certain eligible veterans shall be granted a high school diploma; and
- 2. Veterans applying to receive a high school diploma under the Operation Recognition program must meet the following eligibility requirements as follows:
 - World War II between September 16, 1940 and December 31, 1946, and who attended high school between 1937 and 1946, and who would have been a member of a graduation class during the years 1941 through 1950, but did not graduate from high school due to entry into military service; or
 - The Korean War between June 27, 1950 and January 31, 1955, who attended high school between 1947 and 1955 and who would have been a member of a graduation class during the years 1951 through 1957 but did not graduate from high school due to entry into military service; or
 - The Vietnam War between February 28, 1961 and May 7, 1975, who attended high school between 1958 and 1975 and who would have been a member of a graduation class during the years 1961 through 1975 but did not graduate from high school due to entry into military service.
- 3. The Board may award a diploma posthumously to an eligible veteran.
- 4. The Superintendent, or his/her designee, is responsible for implementing the Operation Recognition program, subject to the following requirements:
 - A posting shall be made informing the public of the Operation Recognition program and how to apply for a diploma under the program on the District's Website and social media outlets.
 - Veterans must submit proof of eligibility requirements established in this Resolution.
 - Award of diplomas to eligible veterans must be made by a vote of the Board at a public meeting.
