**The objective and curriculum relevance of the trip are:**

This field trip is the culminating event for the curriculum in the MASH Innovations class. The class follows curriculum from Project Invent, in which students learn how to design, build and pitch an invention to help a community member. On the trip to New York City, students will present their idea to venture capitalists for judging and potential funding. They will also explore potential careers through visits to a variety of tech companies.
